## **Meeting Minutes**

- I. Welcome (2 minutes) (Jamie Reiber) *Meeting Began at 6:35pm*

#### II. Principal Report (5 minutes) (Mr. Bell)

- a. Positive Office Referrals
  - i. Clip system in each Classroom New this year
  - ii. Each student can receive 4 good behavior points a day. Once this is received they can get a selfie with Mr. Bell. #BellfieAn email will go home to the parents or guardians from Mr. Bell notifying you of this as well as attaching the selfie.
