GOAL #2: MATH

- 1. 80% of students in Kindergarten will grow from beginning of the year to end of the year by 7 points in both Beginning Quantity Discrimination (BQD) and Next Number Fluency (NNF).
- 2. 80% of students in grade 1 will grow from beginning of the year to end of the year by 7 points in Advanced Quantity Discrimination (AQD), Missing Number Fluency (MNF), and Computation (Comp).
- 3. 75% of students in grade 2 will grow from beginning of the year to end of the year by 10 points in both Computation (Comp) and Concepts and Applications (C&A).
- 4. 80% of students in grades 3-5 will grow from beginning of the year to the end of the year by 15 points in both Computation (Comp) and Concepts and Applications (C&A).

GOAL #3: WRITING

- 1. 70% of students in Kindergarten will meet grade-level growth goals in writing by growing 3 points from the beginning of the year to the end of the year or maintain their score from the beginning of the year to the end of the year.
- 2. 90% of students in grade 1 will meet grade-level growth goals in writing by growing 3 points from the beginning of the year to the end of the year.
- 3. 70% of students in grades 2-4 will meet grade-level growth goals in writing by growing 3 points from the beginning of the year to the end of the year.
- 4. 70% of students in grade 5 will meet grade-level growth goals in writing by growing 3 points from the beginning of the year to the end of the year or maintain their score from the beginning of the year to the end of the year.

GOAL #4: INSTRUCTION

- 1. 80% of students in grade 1 will grow 10 points on the GSV on G-RADE.
- 2. 70% of students in grade 2 will grow 10 points on the GSV on G-RADE.
- 3. Improve instruction and rigor as measured by 70% of students in grades 3-5 growing 30 points on the raw score on the CDT.

GOAL #5: CULTURE AND CLIMATE

Further develop a trauma-sensitive community that is measured by Mooreland's teacher/family survey.
