New Business:

- Fundraising:

 - 50 cents for a ticket, punch card for 25 tickets for \$10
 - Kids can earn tickets in school to play games
 - Giant A+ rewards- register our school with your Giant grocery store with your bonus card.
 Percentage of what you spent goes into our school account.
 - Box Tops- certain brands have a box top coupon attached to the item. Send in the box tops by the first Friday of the month. First collection October 6. There is also an app for Box Topsyou can scan the item and the receipt. You can double the rewards that go to Bellaire!
 - Color Run- will be fundraiser in the spring. No date set yet.
- PTO Insurance and Non-Profit Status:
 - -PTO is currently working on becoming non-profit. Working with the school district

-PTO is currently looking to purchase insurance to cover the PTO and the board- to legitimize things to make a more efficient board. When we get a formal quote from the insurance company, we will have a membership vote.

 - -Mrs. Renninger (Kindergarten)- pieces to fix the letter machine reimburse \$39.20. **Mr. Bell declined and said this request will not be fulfilled.**
 - -Mrs. Alandar- tshirt for 4th/5th grade musical (138 students approx.- \$7-9/ tshirt = \$966-\$1242) motion to try to find an alternative solution to help raise the funds- motioned by Katie Spencer, seconded by Amanda Moore. Unanimous vote.

Party Planning:

All volunteers need to have clearances. Go to district website and fill out- need 3 forms. Child
abuse history certification, the PA State Police Request for Criminal Record Check, and FBI
Criminal Background Check – only need the FBI Criminal check (\$25) if you haven't lived in PA for
more than 10 years in a row. Need the verification form if you have lived in PA for more than 10
years.

- IF you don't have clearances, you can come in to have lunch with your child, be a secret reader, book fair volunteer, picture day helper. If you're alone with kids then you will need your clearances.
- parents plan the classroom parties for the year (5th grade combines the three classes for one big party in the gym)
