

# Carlisle Area School District—Secondary Education Summer Learning Program Handbook - 2024

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## SUMMER LEARNING INFORMATION

The purpose of the Summer Learning Program is to **recover credit for courses that were failed during the school year**. Students enrolled in the Summer Learning Program will typically take one or two courses. In some situations, students may be required to take more courses to meet their academic requirements or to help them recover additional credits/learning.

### **Summer Learning Program 2024 Dates:**

Tuesday, June 11<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, June 13<sup>th</sup>  
Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, June 20<sup>th</sup> (No School on June 19<sup>th</sup>)  
Monday, June 24<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, June 27<sup>th</sup>  
Monday, July 1<sup>st</sup> through Wednesday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> (No School on July 4<sup>th</sup>)  
Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup> through Wednesday, July 10<sup>th</sup>

### **Summer Learning Program 2024 Times:**

Location: Wilson Middle School  
Students must attend either one or two sessions daily (based on their course requirements).  
Session 1 runs from 8:30 AM to 11:00 AM  
Session 2 runs from 11:30 AM to 2:00 PM

### **Attendance Requirements:**

- Students are expected to attend each day and to arrive promptly.
- There will be no sessions on Wednesday, June 19<sup>th</sup>.
- There will be no sessions on Thursday, July 4<sup>th</sup>
- Students may miss a day with a doctor's note. Extensions will **not** be granted past **July 10<sup>th</sup>**.
- Students may be dismissed for the Summer Learning Program **without tuition reimbursement** if they accrue unexcused absences.

### **Summer Learning Program Format:**

- Students will be enrolled in online courses to remediate courses failed during the year.
- Work will be completed on computers, on worksheets, on paper, independently, and/or at school.
- Work will be submitted either in person or online and graded as such.
- Carlisle teachers will be present to monitor progress, grade specific assignments, offer tutoring, assist with course content, and answer questions.
- Students **must** complete each remedial course and earn a grade of **at least 65% to pass**.

Students are expected to complete all assignments within the provided timeframe. Students may access their courses at home to either stay on track for completion, or to get ahead in their course(s). A student may successfully complete their required course(s) prior to the end of summer learning session in which case they will not be required to attend. Students will receive a written form from the principal to acknowledge the completion of the course.

### **Credit and Grades:**

Students who successfully complete a Summer Learning Program remedial course will receive credit for the course which will count toward graduation. The transcript, however, will reflect the grade of 65%. If the student takes an alternate course to the course failed during the school year, the student may have an opportunity to earn a percentage grade reflective of 100% to 0% (these are high school elective courses only).

### **Tuition:**

Tuition is set at \$100.00 per course and is non-refundable. **Students may be dismissed without refund if found in violation of Summer Learning Attendance or Behavior Expectations.** Payment in full must be submitted by Monday, June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024 to attend.

❖ Cash: Families may also pay with cash. Exact change is required. Payment may be submitted to the Swartz Guidance Office. Please place cash in an unsealed envelope titled with the **student's name, grade level, and number of courses paid.**

### **Lap top Distribution:**

Laptop distribution for the summer learning plan will occur on Monday (06/10/2024) from 11:00AM—1:00PM and 3:00PM—4:30PM at the Wilson Middle School Main Lobby.

### **Transportation:**

Transportation will not be provided for the Summer Learning Program. Please plan accordingly.

### **Registration:      **Open - Wednesday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, through Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024****

Students identified for Summer School will meet with their School Counselor starting in May. Students and parents must complete the Summer Learning Plan Online Application by Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

### **Food and Drinks:**
